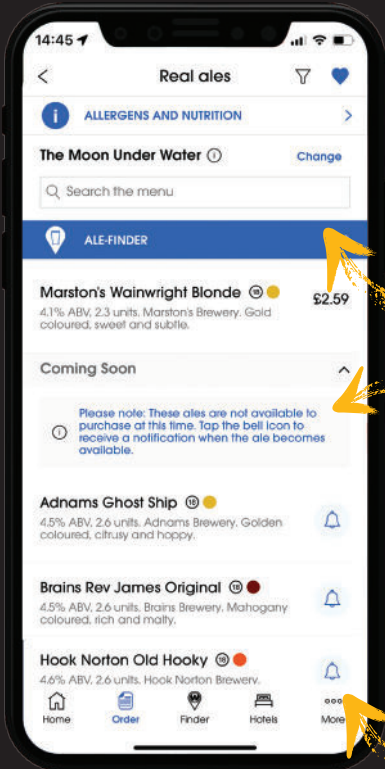

Signature EP 3.4% ABV

Signature Brew, Walthamstow, London. Est. 2011

This yellow pale ale has notes of grapefruit, gooseberry and lychee on the nose, leading to a very crisp character and mouth-filling citrus flavour.

Hops: Citra



Siren Yu Lu 3.8% ABV

Siren Craft Brew, Finchampstead, Berkshire. Est. 2013

This hazy straw-coloured beer is brewed using Earl Grey tea and lemon zest, resulting in a zesty bergamot flavour and a loose-tea bitterness, complementing its peach and apricot notes.

Hops: Cascade, Chinook, Ekuanot



By The Horns Foundry 4.2% ABV

By The Horns Brewery, Salfords, Surrey. Est. 2012

This black stout delivers light roasted malt notes and rich coffee and chocolate flavours, with hints of vanilla sweetness, resulting in a smooth, easy-drinking character.

Hops: Goldings, Pilgrim



Mad Squirrel Aussie Aussie Aussie 4.4% ABV

Mad Squirrel Brewery, Hemel Hempstead, Hertfordshire. Est. 2004

Brewed with Australian hops, this straw-coloured beer pays homage to the land down under. Juicy notes of passion fruit, mango and citrus provide a refreshing character and balancing bitterness.

Hops: Galaxy, Vic Secret



Twickenham Onyx 4.5% ABV

Twickenham Brewery, Twickenham, London. Est. 2004

This new black IPA has a prominent hop aroma, leading to notes of grapefruit, pine and spicy hops, resulting in a crisp, assertive bitterness in the finish.

Hops: Chinook



Redemption Red Eye Rye 4.6% ABV

Redemption Brewery, Tottenham, London. Est. 2010

This new red-hued beer has a smooth and malty character, with a slight spiciness. Its subtle earthy dark fruit notes provide a balanced, complex flavour.

Hops: Bramling Cross, WGV



Southwark The Clink Pale Ale 4.7% ABV

Southwark Brewery, Southwark, London. Est. 2014

This golden pale ale has a massive hit of grapefruit and lemon citrus hop flavours, combined with a subtle malt balance to deliver a full-bodied character and lingering bitter finish.

Hops: Cascade, Citra



Windsor & Eton Eureka! 4.9% ABV

Windsor & Eton Brewery, Windsor, Berkshire. Est. 2010

This new copper-coloured beer has an inviting pine aroma, followed by citrus and stone fruit flavours and a lasting, earthy, herbal and grassy finish.

Hops: Bramling Cross, Columbus, Eureka



Burning Sky Dignified & Old 5.4% ABV

Burning Sky Brewery, Fittle, East Sussex. Est. 2013

This black beer is a modern interpretation of a classic old ale, aged on toasted oak chips to give vanilla notes which complement the rich malt flavours.

Hops: Chinook, Perle



Portobello Sauce on the Side 5.4% ABV

Portobello Brewery, Portobello, London. Est. 2012

This black stout uses an exciting range of malts to produce a sweet, spicy flavour and easy-drinking (yet complex) character, complemented by notes of cranberry, cinnamon and ginger.

Hops: Bramling Cross, Cascade (UK)



Pints

East London Bedrock 5.5% ABV

East London Brewery, Leyton, London. Est. 2011

This new amber-coloured beer is brewed in the classic ESB style, with its bold blend of malts delivering a slightly sweet, full-bodied caramel and biscuit character, with balancing hop notes.

Hops: Challenger, Fuggles, Goldings



Anspach & Hobday The IPA 6.0% ABV

Anspach & Hobday Brewery, Croydon, London. Est. 2014

This golden-amber beer has an inviting hop aroma, leading to resinous and fruity flavours and a long, lasting finish. It was voted CAMRA's 'champion IPA of Britain' and overall silver-medal winner in the 'champion beer of Britain' final, in 2024.

Hops: Ekuanot, Enigma, Summit



Cans

Camden Pale 4.0% ABV 330ml

Camden Town Brewery, Camden, London. Est. 2010

This pale ale is hoppy and fruity, with the citrus notes balanced by a subtle maltiness.

Hops: Citra, Perle, Simcoe



East London Hopside Down 5.0% ABV 440ml

East London Brewery, Leyton, London. Est. 2011

New Zealand pale ale with grapefruit, passion fruit, peach and pine notes.

Hops: Kohatu, Motueka, Motuere, Nelson Sauvin, Southern Cross



By The Horns Skydust 5.5% ABV 440ml

By The Horns Brewery, Salfords, Redhill. Est. 2011

A hazy IPA with a balanced fruity blend of light tropical and citrus notes.

Hops: Bru-1, Citra, Galaxy, Sabro



Signature Backstage IPA 5.6% ABV 440ml

Signature Brew, Walthamstow, London. Est. 2011

IPA with tropical flavours of passion fruit, tangerine and berries.

Hops: Mosaic, Simcoe



The Wild Beer Co Everstone 5.8% ABV 440ml

The Wild Beer Co, Ashford. Est. 2012

This hazy New Zealand IPA delivers ripe stone fruit juiciness, where sweet peach is balanced with a spicy zing from malted and flaked oats and rye malt.

Hops: Eclipse, Rakau and Wai-iti



Anspach & Hobday The IPA 6.0% ABV 440ml

Anspach & Hobday Brewery, Croydon, London. Est. 2013

A resinous and fruit-forward IPA with British malt and American hops.

Hops: Ekuanot, Enigma, Summit
